

JOB VACANCY - MECHANICAL MAINTENANCE APPRENTICE

Job purpose: To work as an apprentice member of the Axion Maintenance Engineering team, working on various maintenance tasks across the site. The Maintenance Engineering Apprentice will be expected to learn all aspects of maintenance including welding and fabrication.

Location: Trafford Park, Manchester

Job type: Full time, shifts.

Contracted hours: Average 39.5 hours per week, Monday - Thursday 06:00 - 14:30, Friday 06:00 - 14:00

The aim of the apprenticeship is to achieve a level of knowledge and understanding where you will be able to carry out the following tasks independently and as part of a team.

Principle duties:

- Perform routine mechanical assembly operations in accordance with Company instructions and procedures.
- Undertake various types of maintenance around site, including but not limited to gearbox changes, bearing changes, belt replacement, welding and routine fabrication, routine electrical tasks,
- Operate hand tools, light machinery, and actively demonstrate all safety policies and procedures.
- Carry out all site PPMs, using appropriate equipment and processes provided.
- Manufacture and assemble fabricated and mechanical components, from drawings.
- Maintain a consistent standard of work and performance that complies with regulatory and QA (Quality Assurance) standards.
- Ensure that the performance of work meets safety goals.
- Inspect own work to assure accuracy in accordance with Company and/or customer requirements.
- Assist in the development and implementation of 'projects and improvement initiatives' and identify where improvements in any area of work can be achieved.
- Have a can-do attitude to enable problem solving and site maintenance delivery.
- Carry out any other reasonable tasks to ensure site and plant availability.
- To work in line with the company mission, vision and values

- 3 GCSEs including Mathematics, English and a science or IT based subject
- Working towards Industry recognised qualification in maintenance (level 3 NVQ in Maintenance and Plant Operations)
